

Programming Workshop Terms and Conditions

General

The following terms and conditions apply to all holiday programming workshop activities unless otherwise stated within the specific activities listed below;

- Our sessions will run at The Mosman Art Gallery on the advertised dates unless the council has closed the Gallery. If we do need to change the venue, we reserve the right to amend the venue without any obligation to refund the purchase price but will endeavor to give you as much notice as possible
- The student must respect the teachers and other attendees in the class. Sydney Programming School has the right to request the removal from the session, of any child causing significant disruption or safety risk to themselves or other children.
- Parents/guardians must inform the Sydney Programming School staff if you remove your child during a session.
- Having a lunch box and water bottle are recommended for all children attending the session.
- Sydney Programming School is committed to being sun aware. All children given signed permission for a walk from parents/guardians must have a hat during the sessions.
- Children with no signed permission for a walk from their parents/guardians will remain in class under Sydney Programming School staff supervision.
- We reserve the rights to cancel any outside activities if there is the wet or very hot weather.
- All out side activities will be held at Alan Border Oval under Sydney Programming staff supervision unless the council has closed the oval.
- All small breaks will be held outside the Art Gallery (backyard) under Sydney Programming School staff supervision unless there is the wet or very hot weather.
- Non attendance when a session has not been officially cancelled by Sydney Programming School means the session is lost.

- Once payment has been received no refunds will be provided except with prior written agreement from Sydney Programming School. No refund will be given if you change your mind. If your child suffers a long term illness such as a broken limb, or other extreme circumstances, please notify Sydney Programming School straight away. Sydney Programming School will consider putting accounts on hold or issue a credit note at its discretion.
- If you wish to change day/time of a class that you have purchased, Sydney Programming School endeavor to give you all the options available. There will be no refund if there is no place available.
- Sydney Programming School or any of its staff accepts no responsibility for any injury, death, loss or damage to the student's personal belongings during a class. Parents/guardians understand and are fully aware of the risks associated with their child participating in the activities provided by Sydney Programming School and participate at their own risk and shall indemnify Sydney Programming School and its staff against all actions, suits, proceedings, demands, costs and expenses which may be taken or made against Sydney Programming School.
